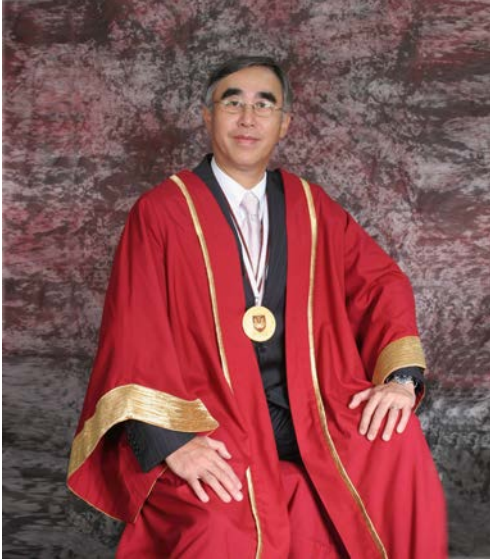




Professor K.N. Lai

Professor Lai graduated from the University of Hong Kong and subsequently received doctorate degrees both in Medicine and in Science. He received his nephrology fellowship training in Adelaide and Cambridge. He was a Visiting Fellow at Corpus Christi College, Cambridge University. Professor Lai is an international advisor to the Royal College of Physicians, London and the Royal Australasian College of Physicians. He has published over 470 full papers in international peer-reviewed journals and 48 book chapters. He had served on the editorial boards of different journals including Kidney International, American Journal of Kidney Diseases, Nephron, Clinical Nephrology, Medicine and Nephrology. He serves on the grant review board of National Health and Medical Research Council (United Kingdom), and Cancer Research (United Kingdom). Administratively, he is the Chief of Medicine, Hong Kong West Cluster hospitals from 2001 and Head of University Department of Medicine, HKU between 2004-2007. He has been the President of the Hong Kong College of Physicians since 2004.
