Professor Chan obtained his MBBS in University College Hospital and Middlesex Joint School of Medicine in London and completed his postgraduate training in the U.K. at the Royal Marsden Hospital before joining the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1993. He was appointed Chairman of the Department of Clinical Oncology in July 2002. He is currently the Chief of Service of Department of Clinical Oncology, Associate Dean (External) of the Faculty of Medicine; as well as the Director of Hong Kong Cancer Institute & Sir Y K Pao Centre for Cancer. His research has focused on the clinical and translational research of Asian Cancers. In particular his work in the multi-modality treatment, development of diagnostic markers and novel therapeutics treatment in nasopharyngeal cancer is well established. He has been awarded Sir David Todd Lecture 2008 by Hong Kong College of Physicians and Prof Chan is currently a Council Member of the College.
