

Arrangement for Annual and Exit Assessments for Hoisting of Black Rainstorm Signal and Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or Above

A) If the signal is hoisted before the assessment

Assessment Session	Scenario	Contingency Arrangement
AM	If the signal is lowered before 7:30 a.m.	All AM assessment sessions will continue
	If the signal is still in force at 7:30 a.m.	All AM assessment sessions will be canceled. Arrangement for PM assessment sessions will depend on the weather conditions at 11:30 a.m.
PM	If the signal is lowered before 11:30 a.m.	All PM assessment sessions will continue
	If the signal still in force at 11:30 a.m.	All PM assessment sessions will be canceled

B) If the signal is hoisted when the assessment is in operation

Signal	Suggested Contingency Arrangement
Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cancel all assessment as soon as possible • Staff and examiners to be released as soon as possible
Black Rainstorm Signal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue assessment for candidates who have turned up • Staffs and examiners should stay at their place of Assessment but Chief Examiners may exercise their discretion to release staff or examiners under exceptional circumstances
