HKCP Scholarship for Medical Students

Objectives of the Scholarship:

- To support and encourage medical students in Hong Kong to undertake clinical or laboratory attachment/research pertaining to the practice and advancement of internal medicine at overseas institutions.
- To support and encourage medical students in Hong Kong to participate in overseas humanitarian services pertaining to the practice in internal medicine.
- To raise the interests in internal medicine among medical students in Hong Kong and nurture them as future physicians early in their career paths.

Amount of Scholarship:

- \$20,000 per award

Quota of Scholarship:

- Up to eight awards per year (4 for HKU and 4 for CUHK)

Eligibility of Applications:

- Medical students studying in University of Hong Kong or Chinese University of Hong Kong, who would like to undertake training in clinical or laboratory attachment/research or humanitarian services at overseas institutions
- The proposed overseas activities should be related to the practice or advancement of internal medicine.
- The proposed overseas activities should be of duration of no less than 4 weeks and have to be approved and endorsed by the respective Medical Faculties.

Rules of Application:

Candidates should submit the following documents to HKCP via their Faculty Offices:

- A statement of not more than 500 words about the proposed activities, including the objectives, details of the activities and expected outcome;

- Curriculum vitae of the candidate;
- Recommendation letter from the Faculty.
- A letter of support and acceptance from the hosting institution or organization;
- Information about concurrent scholarships / funding support awarded to the candidate for the proposed training activities

Selection Criteria:

- The Faculty of each University will shortlist six potential candidates and provide recommendations letter and prioritize each applicant
- The selection panel will review the applications and select the awardees based on their proposal, recommendation from the Faculties and hosting institutions. Candidates who have already secured funding support for the proposed training activities may be accorded a lower priority.
- Candidates who plan to undertake laboratory or clinical research should have obtained approval from the hosting institutions about safety and ethical clearance before they conduct their studies.
- The selection panel will make recommendations to the College Council for final approval.

Report to the College:

- A formal report should be submitted to the College within 3 months of return.

Application Procedure:

- Applications should be submitted to HKCP via their Faculty Offices; HKCP address is: Room 603, Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building, 99 Wong Chuk Hang Road, Hong Kong.
- Application will be opened from 1 September to 31 October of each year
- Results will be announced in January of the following year
