


Training in Geriatric Medicine (GeriMed), HKCP

- Core Training (24 months)



- Remarks:

- “Inpatient geriatrics & GDH” can be concurrent with “Outpatient & CGAS” without affecting the duration accredited
- Two of the modules within “Inpatient geriatrics & GDH” can be concurrent (except acute + rehab) but then the accredited training duration of each of the concurrent modules is halved, e.g. 6 months of “Inpatient infirm” concurrent with “Inpatient rehab” will be accredited 3 months of infirm and 3 months of rehab so that the trainee will need 3 more months of full-time training in rehab

Plus

- Optional Training (12 months) in one of:

- General medicine (GeriMed + AIM)
- Geriatric medicine (GeriMed single specialty training)
- Non-AIM specialty (GeriMed + non-AIM specialty)
 - The dual training programme should satisfy and be endorsed by the Specialty Board that one year of non-core training in geriatric medicine is contributed by training in the non-AIM specialty. (Specialty Board Meeting Minutes of 24 June 2011)
